## How to Read to Kids

## The way you read matters more than how long you read.

Make storytime cozy and fun—snuggle up, use silly voices, and let your child turn the pages or choose the book. Pause to laugh together, point to pictures, or let them finish a favorite line. **Keep reading light and joyful**, even if it's the same book over and over.

What children remember most isn't just the story—it's the feeling of connection and delight that comes with it.



## Talking About Books With Kids

When you read with your child, the conversation is just as important as the story itself.

Keep it simple and natural—pause to wonder aloud ("I wonder what will happen next?"), connect the story to your child's life ("That reminds me of when we went to the park"), and invite their opinions ("Which part did you like best?").

There are no right or wrong answers—your goal is to spark curiosity, build vocabulary, and show your child that books are worth talking about.
